What's the Problem? Women in Madison who have been victims of sexual exploitation often become trapped in prostitution and as further victims of trafficking and abuse. This results in an excruciatingly difficult cycle which diminishes self-worth.

Give Hope by: Providing the funding needed for a case manager and peer advocate to assist women in the Madison community with life skills, counseling, intensive case plans and tutoring.

HOPE FOR KNOWLEDGE [FOOD FOR THE HUNGRY, PERU](#)

What's the problem? In the Peruvian village of Monte Rico, five different grade levels are holding classes in one room resulting in noisy, distracting environments. In Todos Unidos, there is no meeting area or building where the community can gather.

Give Hope by: Constructing classroom facilities that are conducive to successful, age-appropriate learning and a community building that inspires community development and unity through trainings, meetings and community events.

HOPE FOR OPPORTUNITY [BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB OF DANE COUNTY](#)

What's the Problem? Children from six different schools rely on the Boys and Girls Club vans for transportation. Frequent breakdowns of these old vans have created safety concerns prompting their immediate need for replacement.

Give Hope by: Provide funds toward new 15-passenger vans and allow students from more than twelve area schools opportunities for tutoring, after-school programming, and college visits.

HOPE FOR THE FUTURE [CARE OF CREATION, KENYA](#)

What's the problem? Deforestation has led to soil erosion, drought and the inability to produce adequate levels of crops. This heavily increases the problem of hunger and poverty.

Give Hope by: Planting thousands of trees through Kenyans to replenish the land and providing training for area farmers on sustainable farming methods.

HOPE FOR HEALING [ORICA MEDICAL CLINIC, HONDURAS](#)
