**Title:** Blind Spots on What it Means to Seek God

**Main Idea:** Establishing justice is part of the core identity of God's people and it hurts Him and His mission when we don't practice it.

### Connecting

1. What's the worst thing you have ever smelled?
2. Does the word "justice" have positive or negative connotations for you?

### Understanding

1. Read Amos 5:4-15. What does it look like to seek God?
2. Read Amos 5:21-25. What is God's desire for Israel?
3. How would you describe Israel's problem? What did the solution look like for Israel?
4. Read Deuteronomy 15:1-11; Leviticus 23:22; 25:23-24. How was God's law in these verses designed to address social injustices and end poverty?
5. Why do you think God is so concerned about social justice?

### Living

1. What does it look like to seek justice?
2. How do these passages influence how you worship?
3. What acts of generosity have you witnessed or been a part of in the past?
4. Have you ever participated in Advent Conspiracy in the past? How might Advent Conspiracy help you be generous or engage in social justice this year?
