### Connecting

3. Read Isaiah 1:17. What do you think God expects of those who witness abuse and exploitation?
4. Read Psalm 32: 3-5. What's a precursor to God's forgiveness?

1. Have you ever spoken up or intervened for someone being harassed or ridiculed?
2. Does social media make self-disclosure easier or harder? Why?
3. What was your reaction to Becky's story? What would you say to someone who has had a similar experience?
