The Generous Life: God or Money // Matthew 6:19-24

Main Idea: Our attitude toward money is the key that unlocks our spiritual lives.

Connecting

1. Do you research your purchases thoroughly or are you more spontaneous? Examples?
2. What would you do with \$5000 if it just fell in your lap?

Understanding

1. Read Matthew 6:9-11. How does this prayer (the Lord's Prayer) address our trust in money verses our trust in God?
2. Read Matthew 6:19-24. Jesus uses three contrasting metaphors: treasure (earthly or heavenly), eyes (good or bad), and masters (God or money). From these warnings, what does Jesus want us to understand regarding our relationship with money?
3. Read Matthew 6:25-34. From what you read in this passage, what would you say is the antidote for worry?

Living

1. What does it look like to "seek first his kingdom and his righteousness"? How could you put that into practice?
2. How does having an eternal perspective affect your priorities with finances and how you spend your time?
3. What is your biggest worry related to money or your future?
