What can I expect from the 5th grade retreat?

Your student will join 40-50 other 5th grade students and their 56 ministry leaders in a series of games and activities - both indoors and outdoors. We book the entire camp site for the duration of the event. Students will also have a chance to explore camp and enjoy free time. It is common for this event to be the first night a student has slept anywhere else other than home. We acknowledge and prepare for how meaningful that is to you and your children. Students are placed into separate boys and girls cabins, and every activity is well supervised and safe. One of the main goals of the retreat is to celebrate their 'graduation' from elementary ministries and launch them into middle school ministry. Bed time is 10pm.

Transportation:

Parents are responsible for all transportation of students to and from camp. Directions will be emailed to families one week prior to the event. Please do not arrive any earlier than 5:45pm on Friday May 10.

Registration:

- Cost is \$50/student for cost of meals, lodging, souvenirs
- Requests for financial assistance are kept confidential.

Food:

Please plan on bringing a box of snacks/drinks during time of drop off. Breakfast and lunch will be provided on Saturday. Ensure your child has eaten dinner prior to arriving on Friday. The online registration form will inquire about your student's dietary needs and medications.

What to bring:

- Sleeping bag or sheets, and pillow
- Outdoor clothing
(including sturdy shoes and rain gear)
- Reading material, Bible, notebook, and pen/pencil
- Things to do if your child is an early riser. All students stay in bed until 7am. Students are not allowed out of bed earlier than 7am.

What NOT to bring:

- Personal candy/snacks
- Knives
- Electronics
- Phones (Mobile numbers of on-site Blackhawk Church staff will be given to parents in case of emergency)
