3. Read Ruth 4:12-17. What's the impact of hesed on Boaz and Ruth? What's the impact on the community?
4. Read Ruth 4:18-22. What do you think is the significance of this genealogy? What do you think the genealogy says about how God works?

2. How is God at work in the "common places" of your life?
3. How would you like to see hesed transform your community? What role might you be able to play in that transformation?
