Read

Read Exodus 3 and 6.

Discuss

- In many cultures, a person's name holds significance. What does your name mean? Is there a story behind why you are named what you're named? If so, share it with the group.
- Read Exodus 3 and Exodus 6:1-8 together as a group. What stands out to you? What confuses you? What questions do you have about the text?
- In Exodus 3 and 6, God shares with Moses that his name is I AM- Yahweh. What is the difference between knowing God as El Shadday and knowing God as Yahweh? Which way of knowing God do you find yourself emphasizing more in your life?
- What are you trusting El Shadday for? And in what ways is I AM inviting you to know Him as all-powerful and all-sufficient in our world today?
