#### Reflect + Discuss

- Have you ever had the experience of being surrounded by people from different backgrounds? How did that make you feel?
- Read Galatians 3:1-5. What stands out to you from the text and what questions do you have? What is Paul's point in this passage?
- Read Genesis 12:1-4 and 15:1-6. What did God promise Abraham, and how was that meant to affect the world?
- Read Galatians 3:6-9. How are the Gentiles connected to Abraham? What are the implications of this passage?
- What does it mean to be part of a global, multicultural family of believers? How can we reflect God's love and desire for multi-ethnic community within our own church community?
