Reflect + Discuss

- What comes to mind when you think about the idea of royalty?
- Read Psalm 8. What stands out to you from the text? What questions do you have?
- How do you feel knowing that God declares you are royalty? Read Genesis 1:26-27. How does knowing that God created humans to rule in His image affect how you live today?
- How are the two sides of seeing yourself as the center of everything (like Scar from *The Lion King*) and devaluing your place in the world (like Simba from *The Lion King*) both rejections of our true relationship with God, the high king? Which side of the spectrum do you tend to fall on?
- Sin shows up in our lives when we forget our identity as God's royal ambassadors. Where in your life today might sin be "crouching at your door?" Is there a specific next step you can take to address this sin?
