- Read Acts 2:1 – 13. What stands out to you from the text? What questions do you have?
- What is the significance of fire landing on each person at Pentecost? How often do you think about the Holy Spirit within you?
- Read Genesis 11:1 – 9. How was creating different languages both God's judgment and blessing to the world? In what way was the Holy Spirit descending at Pentecost like a reversal of what happened at the Tower of Babel?
- Where in your life do you interact with people from different cultures than your own? How can you be intentional about building relationships with people from other cultures?
- How does knowing that the early church began as a multicultural and multilingual community affect your perception of God's kingdom? How can we work toward God's vision for a multicultural church family?
