Responsibilities

➤ **Blackhawk Downtown Worship Arts**

- Work closely with the Director of Worship Arts to help the site's Worship Arts ministry fulfill its mission.
- Champion a meaningful Sunday worship experience for the Downtown site.
 - Participate in planning meetings for Sunday programming, and plan worship services.
 - Regularly lead for worship services (approximately three to four Sundays per month).
 - Act as the producer for Sunday services (e.g., work closely with the Lead Pastor, Tech Team, and Welcome Team; give feedback on ambiance and flow; oversee service length).
 - Provide a consistent Sunday pastoral presence for the congregation.
- Equip, coach, and encourage the site's Worship Arts adjunct staff, volunteers, leaders, and interns.
- Manage the site's Worship Arts projects, schedules, budget, and administrative tasks.
- Act as the Worship Arts staff coach for College-Age Ministry (CAM).
 - Collaborate with CAM staff on worship vision and direction.
 - Help develop worship leaders and volunteer teams to ensure a worship presence at weekly CAM gatherings during the school year.

➤ **Blackhawk Downtown Site Team**

- Be an active member of the Blackhawk Downtown staff team.
 - Work closely with the Lead Pastor of Blackhawk Downtown to help the site fulfill its mission.
 - Collaborate with the Downtown Team on ministry vision, goals, planning, and evaluation.
 - Provide additional leadership and pastoral presence for the site at the discretion of the Lead Pastor of Blackhawk Downtown.
- Help maintain a strong relationship as church-in-residence with our host organization, [Upper|House](#).
 - Build and strengthen relationships with Upper|House staff.
 - Communicate regularly to ensure best use of shared resources and space.
 - Help manage Worship Arts-related equipment that is shared among organizations.
- Build relationships with parachurch ministries on campus and downtown.

➤ **Central Worship Arts Leadership**

- Participate in ministry oversight, vision development, and evaluation.
- Identify, engage, train, equip, and develop ministry volunteers and leaders.
- Participate periodically in the organization and implementation of Worship Arts-sponsored events and projects, or other ministry's events or projects requiring Worship Arts staff support.
- Provide leadership in other areas of the ministry based on need, gifting, capacity, and interest.
